3. 16:40 News from chair and principal

Description:

3.1 Dom to give update of news from around the school.

Minutes:

- Lennart Newmann, volunteer over the past 2.5 years, passed away. Admin followed school grief plan. Two staff attended funeral.
 - Especially Grade 2 have been affected by Lennarts passing. The teachers have been handling it. Conversation about timeline for communication about information like this.
- New toilet, downstairs for the small kids. General cleanliness in toilets is a current issue. Also seen
 on Student wellbeing survey. Boys/girls/grade 0 have their own toilet now. Dom visited classes and
 message on Aula.

• Expansion January 24 update:

- due to expanded staff, new cooperative meeting structures introduced. Rotation of meetings focused on wellbeing, events, and subject teams.
- updated process for concern cases involving PPR and familiedialog
- expanded vikar pool- new hires. New vikar receive an A-Z guide and are shadowing in classes to learn routine and expectations
- Issues around toilets at Borgerskolen- unclean, BS students vaping and knocking

News on classrooms for August 24

- Political committee BSU approved option 1, which is keeping all classes together at Skimminge. This solution is to install 4 temporary building on the football court area. New football courts to be built.

- The money for the building has been approved by the municipality.
- School board is being shown illustrations of how the pavilions will look like. Doing the
 electricity for the buildings will take time. It is expected that the pavilions and electricity
 will be ready mid-October. Awareness whether the placing of the new pavilions will create
 a "dark corner" in the school yard.
- LIS will look into where to place the students until then.
- The Gym next to Borgerskolen will from August be handled by LIS. The room above the Gym can be used for staff meeting room.
- It is expected that Grade O from August will have around 16-17 students.
- Questions from the board on whether it is possible to have the new football yard in place before the current one is taken down. Alternatively moveable football goals can be used.
- Job fair, LIS attended the Lolland Job fair in February. Grade 8 and 9 also visited for inspiration.
- Anne, deputy head of Maribo Skole, onsite leader at Borgerskolen, has resigned.
- Optagelseprøver- an exam that is required if the students want to attend a Gymnasium.

4. 16:55 Student council

Description:

4.1 Iulia and Bo to update on news form the student council.

Minutes:

Presentation of bad language focus. Trying to engage the students and also creating awareness of the influence that the oldest students may have on the younger students. After Easter Break the presentation will be taken out in the classes.

In the student council there is a lot of talk about football. Wishes from students. Talk about how to share the time on the football ground.

Description:

Minutes

5.1 92% answered the survey. Positive result. Teachers are following up on the results together and in the classes. The wellbeing survey and the result of them give a good chance to talk about the words and questions – and how to define things like "friendship", "loneliness", "bullying".

The student council suggests that there could be a focus on trying to find out who responded negatively in the survey if a class had many negative comments.

In udskoling there is a focus on bedtime – some students are going late to bed.

- 5.2 LK has a focus on the importance of handling bullying and violent episodes correctly.
- 5.4 There are open cases of bullying. Bullying also includes poor dynamics. The school is communicating clearly about the process and how we are handling bullying cases. Sometimes reports are received but it is determined to not be a case of bullying.

Skolestyrken (antibullying tool) is able to help classes struggling with bad dynamics.

The student council suggests a less strict approach from the teachers in the older grades whenever the students are joking with one another. It sometimes seems as if the teachers are controlling more than they need to.
